### The Structural or Hull & Structure Survey

Occasionally the BoatBuy or BoatSure/Full Condition Survey may be considered unnecessary, for example when purchasing a nearly new or trade stock vessel with the benefits of remaining manufacturers' warranties, or a refit project or as peace of mind if you are happy evaluating the gear and systems yourself or often used in combination with a specialist engineers inspection on a larger vessel.

This survey can be combined with a valuation for finance

- Sail Drive, Stern Drive Installation.
- Hull Fittings and Sea Valves.
- Hull to Deck Joint.
- Decks. Coach Roof and Cockpits.
- Hatches and Port Lights.
- Mast Support and Chain Plates.
- Engine & Machinery Installation.
- Overall Comment.
